For the attention of the Parish Council.

I have noted my work on your behalf during the remainder of July below.

In your Parish:

- Attended PC Meeting. Received highways concerns which I am working through.
- SCC Highways to provided footway safety inspection on 18th August 2026 for Wilford Bridge/ B1083. Requested SCC Highways cover some additional items provided on 'Sutton Village.pdf' highways report from PC member.
- Began discussions with ESDC and Woodbridge SCC Councillor on Sutton Hoo connectivity.

Across Wilford:

- Parish Council attendance and started Friday telephone surgery.
- Distribution of Friday Surgery poster and Highways Reporting poster.
- Further highways works and safe crossing reviewed and supported.
- Funding for community projects reviewed.
- Liaised with Children and Young People Services to review corporate services and schools to determine effective representation.
- Liaised with strategic highways and infrastructure services, active travel planning to explore funding status for future projects.
- Organising a Health and Safety workshop with cabinet member to review fire preparedness (due 7th August).
- Liaised on fire and access provision with East Suffolk DC.
- Lobbied MP Jenny Riddle-Carpenter on mobile signal infrastructure.
- Organised briefing with cabinet member to review mobile library provision.

Across Suffolk:

- Attended full Suffolk County Council meeting and questioned cabinet members on mobile library provision.
- Attended mandatory training.
